This is Paul's summation of the message of his letter to the Galatians, written in his own hand. We learn once again that the Spirit is very jealous to teach us the life transforming power of the gospel of God's grace. In Paul's simple, concise closing words he restates that:

God's new creation is produced by the cross of Christ, alone.

If this is true, then there is no place for boasting. Paul's summation shows the two opposing gospel errors:

God's new creation is produced by the cross, not by adding religious discipline



Children's Message: New City Catechism
Question 31: What do we believe by true faith?
